An American in the Debrecen Prison

September 13, 2016

"On September 12, 2016 our Institute was visited by Mike Van Horn who is the representative of the American Rock of Ages Ministries. The Bible based Reintegration Program, which was developed by the American organization, is applied in our Institute for one year and a half with success. Our guest partook in a Business Meeting with the Commander and the Chaplain of our Institute, and also with Zsolt Kovacs Minister who functions as the Hungarian representative of the Organization. At the meeting the participants evaluated the results that had been accomplished so far and discussed the possibilities of further development and improvement. After the constructive spirited discussion, the guest personally attended a Reintegration Class and spoke to the inmates."

As far as we know prior to our visiting Hungary there were no Baptist witnesses in the prisons. While on the same trip Brother Van Horn visited the country of Albania and introduced our ministry and the Lord has again opened a great door.
