As we approach the Thanksgiving season, God has brought us to a very special place from which we can reflect on all His blessings over the past year.

It was one year ago, on the 19th of this month, that we were traveling back home after a month and a half of meetings in Minnesota. We had almost reached Madison, Wisconsin when we had a terrible accident in which our vehicle was totaled. After the accident we spent several days in local hospitals and one week as guests in the home of a pastor and his wife while we recuperated and made arrangements to travel back home. As we send out this prayer letter, we are currently guests in that same home, after presenting our ministry at the church there on Sunday. God has been so good to us, and we rejoice in His blessings.

Here are some of the many ways in which God has blessed us since that time.

- A new car—new to us, that is
- Safety in traveling in 25 states and two countries (Canada and US). We have traveled over 33,752 miles since January.
- Over \$110,000 in medical bills related to the accident are paid.
- Christians have been encouraged and the lost have had the gospel preached to them. There are so many stories to tell! Here is a recent example. One retired man came up to us after the service and told us that God had placed it on his heart to go back to work so he would have more money to give for missions! We praise the Lord for His work in the hearts of His people.

During the past month we have presented our ministry in Illinois, Wisconsin, and Minnesota. For December we will be presenting our ministry closer to home (Tennessee and Georgia) except for one trip to Illinois.
