Dear Pastors and Friends,

We are finally back in Germany after a 16 week furlough. We were able to get to 21 churches while we were home, and of those 10 were new presentations. We are praying that God will supply us with some additional support from these churches and that we were a blessing and a help to them. We are thankful for the way that God has provided for our daughter Kimberly. She now has a full-time job in Ponca City and is staying busy in our home church. We are so thankful to our pastor for the way that he is taking care of her. Kaitlyn is in her second year at Heartland and is doing great. Another unexpected blessing for us was that I was able to preach at Heartland Baptist Bible College and speak at their missionary prayer band. It was a blessing to see how many young people are open to going wherever God wants to send them. I was able to talk to 3 young men in particular who are praying about coming to Germany as missionaries. I would ask that you pray with me for these young men and that God would send more laborers into this ripening field of Europe.

As we hit the ground here in Germany, we had a friend day planned on October 9. We saw God work in the hearts of our friends and neighbors as many were invited. We know that without Him our best efforts are in vain, but with His hand on us even our blunders will produce fruit. God almost doubled our attendance for this day. Our theme was "O taste and see that the Lord is good" and each visitor received a large homemade cookie.

With everything else we are still looking in earnest for a new building. I believe that we are to the point where we need to make a change, and we know that we will only find the right place with God's help. We also know that God will need to work in the lives of our people for this to take place.

Finally, I would like to offer our video that we used on our furlough to any of you that might be able to use this in your churches. It can be sent as a DVD through the mail or we can make it available as a download. Also it would be a pleasure for us to Skype or FaceTime with you and your church if you would want to set up a time for us to do that.
